


<b>Assessment calculation</b>			
Severity:	Likelihood/Probability:	Action - General "Rules of Thumb":	
0 No injury or illness.	0 None to very low.	<p>If the risk can be reduced without any additional resources, it should be reduced, even if it is already at a low level.</p> <p>If the risk is high (eg: greater than 16), you should normally do something to reduce the risk.</p> <p>If you are not sure whether a particular risk should be reduced or not, you should seek advice from your safety professional or Manager.</p>	
1 First Aid injury or illness.	1 Very unlikely.		
2 Minor injury or illness. Includes where a person would lose up to 7 days away from work.	2 Unlikely.		
3 7-Day injury or illness. Where a person would lose more than 7-days off work or on light duties.	3 Likely.		
4 Major injury or illness.	4 Almost certain.		
5 Fatality or disabling injury/illness	5 Definite.	<p>Risk classification - 0 – 5 Low risk, 6 – 15 Med risk, 16 – 25 High risk</p>
