- ensure, Suppliers as a minimum comply with all statutory and other legal requirements relating to the employment, safety, and environmental impacts of their business, as our own company does.
- encourage engagement with, learning from, respecting of and supporting of the communities and cultures with which we operate.

Our suppliers collaborating with our Corporate Social Responsibility Policy shall commit to continuous improvement, as we do, towards compliance with the employment, safety and environmental standards specified, both in their own companies and those of their suppliers.
